MEMBER NOTE

1. INSURANCE: The College provides “Student & Faculty Safety Insurance Scheme”.

2. HEALTH CARE SERVICE: The college has a Clinic with a qualified nurse and a visiting doctor to attend to First Aid and emergency cases.

3. ANTI-RAGGING : Ragging means Display of noisy, Disorderly Conduct, Doing any act which causes or likely to cause physical or physiological harm or raise apprehension on fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution. Thus ragging includes,

- Teasing, Abusing or Playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to a student (or)
- Asking the student to do any act or perform something which a student will not carry out in the ordinary courses, willingly.

Ragging is totally prohibited in the institution, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished. The institution may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- Two years imprisonment.
- Fine to the tune of Rs.2.5 Lakhs
- Dismissal from the educational Institution.
- Shall not be admitted in any other educational Institution.

Rules & Regulations

1. Class Hours

- The first bell for the class is rung at 9.25 a.m / 12.10 p.m. and the second bell at 9.30 a.m. /1.45 p.m. for the commencement of the class for Forenoon and Afternoon session. A bell is given at the end of each period. A long bell goes at the end of the day at 1.45pm
- At the first bell, students shall go to their respective classes and take their seats so as to be present when the teacher enters.
- Students shall occupy the seats assigned to them and shall not change them without the permission of the teacher.
- No student shall leave the classroom during a lecture without the permission of the teacher.

2. Attendance

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each hour.
- A student who is not in the class when attendance is taken will be marked absent.
- Late-comers will not be admitted to the class without an admission slip from the respective Head/Dean or a person authorized by him/her for the purpose.

3. Leave of Absence

- A student requiring leave for a portion of a class must apply to the Class In- charge in person before the class begins or at the Break.

- A student requiring leave should submit the leave form to the Head of the Department
- **All leave applications must be in the prescribed form available in the College Office.**
- A student who applies for long leave on grounds of illness must attach a medical certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner with his/her leave application form. In any case, the medical certificate must reach the College Office within 5 days of the student's return to the classes. Medical Certificates submitted later will not be accepted.
- Continued absence without leave for more than 10 working days will render a student liable to have his / her name struck off the rolls of the College.
- All leave applications must be countersigned by the parent or guardian. In the case of hostel students, the applications must be countersigned by the Deputy Warden. Attendance position of the students will be displayed on the notice board at the end of each month. Students are advised to check their attendance particulars. Ignorance of any such notice thus displayed will not be accepted as an excuse. Any discrepancy should be brought to the notice of the Principal in writing within a week for scrutiny.
- As per University Norms, the candidate should hold 75% of attendance to attend the University Examination. Candidates who have earned only 50% to 65% of attendance will be withheld from taking the semester examination, but may be permitted to attend the next semester after paying the prescribed fees. Students with attendance below 50% will be detained as per University norms.
- Attendance will be granted to the students who participate in any co-curricular, extra-curricular, sports, NCC, NSS, Competition etc., on submission of necessary certificate within a week of participation. Such certificates should be routed to the office through the Head of the department.

4. Good Manners & Behaviour

- Students attending classes, meetings or other gatherings within the College are expected to be presentably dressed in accordance with approved etiquette.
- When a student meets a member of the staff for the first time in the day, he / she must greet him / her appropriately.

- Students are forbidden to smoke in the College premises, to write or make any mark on the walls or desks or throw paper or ink on the walls or floors of the classrooms or corridors. Severe action will be taken against the offenders.
- Students are not allowed to loiter about or stand in the verandahs or corridors of the College during class hours.

5. Disciplinary Regulations

- Students should abstain from active participation in party or communal politics.
- Students should wear the ID Card inside the campus
- Students should be in proper dress code as per imposed by the Institution.
- Coming late to the college is a serious breach of discipline
- Students should cultivate the habit of reading notice, displayed on the college notice-boards.
- Smoking in the premises of the college, spitting, pasting posters, scribbling on the tables and walls, are strictly prohibited and throwing of waste paper only in the dustbin
- The Principal or other College authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character which regulate the conduct of the students on the rolls. So far such rules seem necessary to maintain the creditability, usefulness and reputation of the College or hostel.
- The Principal shall have full power to inflict the following punishments in the interest of the students or the Institution: Fine, lack of attendance, loss of term certificate, suspension or expulsion.
- Students should not indulge in any activity leading to the disruption of peace and discipline, or dislocation of the normal functions or meetings. Those who are found guilty of violation of this rule will attract any of the punishments mentioned in Disciplinary Regulations.
- Students who are guilty of (a) rude language towards the staff of the College (b) assaulting or attempting to assault fellow-students or the College employees or other staff of the College will attract any of the punishments mentioned in Disciplinary Regulations(The Principal shall have full power to inflict the following punishments in the interest of the students or the Institution: Fine, lack of attendance, loss of term certificate, suspension or expulsion)
- No private collection of funds shall be made from the students or the staff without the prior permission of the Principal.

- Bicycles, two wheelers, cars etc., must be parked only in the parking lots meant for the purpose. Use of helmet is compulsory. Only riders wearing helmets will be permitted enter the campus.
- Any lost property found must be handed over to the Principal chamber from whom the owner can reclaim it after establishing his ownership.
- Possession and Consumption of alcohol, chewing gums, paan, smoking and illicit drugs inside the premises of University/Institutions are prohibited and liable for punishment.

Students shall not:

- a. Indulge in demonstrations and strikes.
- b. Participate in any form of intimidation, coercion or wrongful confinement or any violent activity which will prevent any student, employee or officer/authority of the institution from discharging their duties.

6. Fee Regulations

- The academic year for fee transaction purposes shall be divided into three terms
- The month of **JUNE/SEPTEMBER AND DECEMBER.**
- (i)The First term commences from the re-opening of the College after the summer vacation and continues till the end of the month June
- (ii)The Second term commences to the mid of the semester upto the month end of September.
- (iii) The Third term commences to the End of the semester upto the month end of December.
- The Term fees shall be paid in three payment except where otherwise specified.
- Every student has to pay the whole fees for the year during any part of which his / her name is on the rolls and his / her attendance registered, whether such fee be paid in one sum or in three payments, except where otherwise specified.
- The whole amount of the first term payment must be paid by a new student before his / her name is on the rolls and his / her attendance registered except where otherwise specified.
- All fees payable by students shall be paid only through Bank account. Students must preserve these fee receipts carefully till the end of the course.
- Students who do not pay the fees by the due dates shall pay a fined after the due dates. Absence with or without leave is no grounds for exemption from this rule.
- Holders of scholarships and fee Concessions from Government or University or College or other sources are also bound by all the foregoing regulations.

- The College reserves the right to increase the rates of fees to all classes at the beginning of any academic year if additional costs have to be met.

7. Admission and Withdrawal

1. Candidates who are admitted on the basis of qualification obtained from the other schools/universities or bodies should fully satisfy all the prescribed conditions for admission and such admissions are subject to confirmation by the College. The provisional admission is entirely at the risk of the candidate. Candidates with qualifications from other schools/universities or bodies should produce an eligibility certificate issued by the concerned authority for consideration during admission.

2. Students who are found to have obtained admission by false representations will be summarily dismissed with the forfeiture of all the fees.

3. A student admitted at any time in the college should pay the whole fee for the academic year. A student who wishes to leave the college will be issued a transfer certificate, after clearing all the dues. If a student leaves the college at the end of the academic year, he/she will receive an attendance certificate.

CLASS ROOM & LABORATORY MANNERS

Students are strictly expected

1. To be polite, dignified, neat and obedient everywhere in the campus.
2. To be seated in the lecture hall five minutes before the commencement of the class.
3. To stand up as a mark of respect when the faculty enters or leaves the class room.
4. To maintain discipline and silence inside the lecture halls and labs
5. Not to loiter outside the classroom during the lecture hours.
6. To take care of their belongings and not to bring any valuable items to the college.
7. Don't bring **MOBILE PHONES** other portable electronic gadgets to the college campus.
8. To use the laptops only for academic purposes.
9. To avoid chewing bubble gum, chocolate and any edible item inside the class room.
10. To submit the Record of experiments (observation note) done in a practical class in the next lab class itself.
11. To avoid being irregular in lab work, thus be disallowed for the next experiment and be marked absent for the lab class.

12. Not to leave the lab, until the given experiment is done and the lab class is over.
13. To be very attentive while doing their lab experiments in the lab classes.
14. All possible caution should be exercised while handling the laboratory equipments.
15. Any breakage, damage or loss to equipment should be reported to the staff concerned immediately. If the student fails to report, he will be held responsible and fined.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The College library is housed in a magnificent building that is constructed almost in the centre of the campus, occupying a carpet area of 1300 sq.ft. The Library is the nerve centre of knowledge and serves the students and staff members with needed information resources. The Library acts as a vital partner in the collaborative learning activities with a wide range of academic resources such as books, journals, current periodicals, back-up volumes, e-resources, CDs/DVDs, Question bank and institutional library membership. The library is fully automated, barcode based system and provides a user – friendly atmosphere. The library is installed with CCTV camera.

The issue of books is regulated as follows:

- Teaching Staff: 4 Books
- Non-Teaching Staff: 2 Books
- UG Students: 2 Books
- PG Students : 3 Books

Issue and Return of Books:

1. A student is entitled to keep a book for 14 days from the date of issue. For staff members the period of issue is one semester.
2. One renewal for a book is permitted and there is no reservation. For renewal, members must bring the book in person.
3. Reference books, Periodicals and copies of University examination question papers will not be lent.
4. Members on receiving the books shall examine them before leaving the library

and report to the In-Charge, if any damage is noticed.

5. Absence from the college will not be permitted as an excuse for delay in returning the books.

6. If a book is not returned within 28 days from the date of issue, students will not be allowed to attend the class.

Loss of Books:

Loss of books should be reported to the Librarian immediately and the person should either replace it with another good copy or pay twice the cost of the book in addition to overdue charges.

Books Reservations:

Members can reserve books and check periodically for their availability.

EXAMINATION CELL

Rules and Regulation of Internal Exam Cell

Examination Cell in the college takes responsibility to monitor all the examinations related such as Continuous Internal Assessment and University Examination. Well qualified and experienced teaching faculty have been given responsibility to take care of this work.

1. Every semester, Two Continuous Internal Assessment Tests and Model Examinations are conducted to evaluate the students performance. The CIA and Model exam are conducted centrally with defined time table.
2. The printed answer books for CIA and Model examinations are provided to the students. Internal Assessment marks are sent to the parents through progress cards./Whatsapp Group.
3. The academic performance is monitored by students' performance in the classrooms through Assignments, Class tests, Group discussions, Case study analysis and Seminars. The students' performances in University examinations (theory and Practical) are examined.
4. Result analysis is monitored by the Chairman, CEO, Principal, IQAC

Coordinator and HODs. Based on subject wise result analysis, suggestions to the teachers are given by the Principal.

5. Tracking student's academic progression using Progress Card / Whatsapp Group to parents are sent regularly.and getting regular feedback from the parents.
6. The results are reviewed in relation to University and neighborhood College with regard to Pass percentage, Number of Distinctions, Rank Holders and other related aspects.
7. Internal Marks are allotted based on the University Rule.
